Any false information or representation made by the applicant shall result in immediate revocation or termination of the scholarship. Applicants will be notified by mail if they are selected to receive the scholarship.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Be a family member or a member in good standing with WVAR (i.e. REALTOR® member, son, daughter, dependent/guardian or grandchild) and provide the name of the active REALTOR® member.
- 2. Submit application on or before March 1 of any calendar year.
- 3. Provide an up-to-date transcript of high school, college or technical grades, including SAT or ACT scores, class rank and acceptance letter.
- 4. Complete student application. (The only information available to the Scholarship Selection Committee is that which the applicant provides. Therefore, it is imperative that the entire application be completed.) Attach all other criteria or information, along with a black and white original photo of the applicant (no photocopies please).
- 5. Two letters of recommendation addressing character, scholarship and potential of applicant—one from a teacher in the school which the applicant currently attends, and the other from a person not related to the applicant. (If the applicant is not a high school or college student currently, then two letters of recommendation from a person not related to the applicant.)
- 6. Complete a 200-word essay as to why you want to be considered for this scholarship. Include anything else you want the committee to know about you.
